

Golfers are spoilt for choice with an abundance of other high-quality courses including Nairn Dunbar, Fortrose and Rosemarkie, and Boat of Garten. You only have to venture 1-hour due North to find Royal Dornoch, a historic links course to rival anywhere in the world.



Mercure Inverness Hotel overlooks The River Ness in an area with a wide selection of live music bars and independent eateries. This hotel has 121 bedrooms which have all been newly refurbished in 2017 to 4-star standard along with the bar and restaurant facilities.
